Appeal for Financial Aid

Students are encouraged to appeal for federal or state aid if they experienced an extenuating circumstance (verified with documentation) that affected their ability to meet requirements for their Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) or scholarship renewal requirements.

Appeal Process:

You can submit your appeal online through MyNMSU, to your Financial Aid Advisor, to your Campus' Financial Aid Office email, or inoffice. After submission, your appeal will be reviewed and considered within 10-14 business days. Please be advised, submitting this appeal does not guarantee that your financial aid will be reinstated.

If you are a Second Degree Seeking student exceeding the allowable time frame of 90 credit hours, you must also include in your appeal a typed statement that answers these questions:

- a) What is your previous degree? Explain why it is insufficient.
- b) Why are you choosing to seek this 2nd degree?
- c) How is this degree going to be beneficial to your career? (increased pay, new position, etc.)
- d) Do you have any experience/involvement in this field? (current employment, volunteering, etc.)
