

## **Dependent Check List**

Step 1: <u>Apply for VA Educational Benefits</u>: We STRONGLY encourage you to apply as soon as possible since the application process can be lengthy.

Step 2: <u>Apply for Admission</u>: Note this can be a lengthy process due to the transcripts.

(If you are an out-of-state student, discuss being an in-state-student for tuition purposes only)

- Step 3: <u>Request Transcripts</u>: College and high school transcripts (Remember Transcripts must come from one institution directly to our institution)
- **Step 4:** <u>Advising</u>: Talk to an Academic Advisor and have them sign your degree plan, along with a copy of Placement Test Scores (if needed).
- Step 5: <u>Certification</u>: The Veterans Programs Office will need a copy of each of the following documents.

- 2. Signed Degree Plan (Advisor)
- 3. Placement Test scores (Advisor)
- 4. VA Certification of Eligibility (VA)
