

# NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY - ALAMOGORDO NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATON

#### **ALAMOGORDO**

Thank you for your interest in applying for the New Mexico State University – Alamogordo (NMSU-A) Nursing program. Currently, NMSU – A has the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree and the Licensed Practical Nurse Certificate of Achievement program. The application process for entry into the AASN or LPN is the same.

Limited spaces are available for the Associate of Applied Science – Nursing and Licensed Practical Nurse programs. Submission of an application for admission to the NMSU-A campus does not guarantee the individual/student placement in a NMSU-A nursing program. Admission to the nursing program is competitive and dependent on the applicant's prerequisite ranking.

Pre-requisites for student eligibility for application submission for the nursing program include:

- Meet with a NMSU-A Academic Advisor and the Director of Nursing for comprehensive advisement
- Submit of all college transcripts to Student Services and the Director of Nursing
- Students must be admitted to NMSU-A. Students are responsible for understanding all of the information in the related-requirement science courses of Anatomy and Physiology I and II, regardless of when these courses were taken. If they were taken more than seven years prior to admission to the Nursing program, these courses must be repeated for credit. Completion of Required Coursework: MATH 1220G, ENGL 1110G, BIOL 2210, and BIOL 2225 with a grade of "C" or higher. BIOL 2310 Microbiology and BIOL 2310L (Microbiology and Lab) are strongly recommended before taking the Health Education Systems, Inc. Admission Assessment (A2).
- Completion of all Clinical Clearance requirements (see attached form)
- Submit a current American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers certification
- Admission Essay: "Why I Want to be a Nurse" (2-3 pages)
- Complete Pre-Registration Screening form

#### **NMSU-A Nursing Program Requirements:**

- HESI A2 Exam: A minimum score of 75% in each category; Anatomy & Physiology, Biology, Chemistry, Grammar, Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary and General Knowledge and a Ranking Composite Score (calculated on the English Composite, Biology, Chemistry & Math scores).
  - NMSU Alamogordo Nursing Program Applicants are required to take the HESI® Admission Assessment
     (A2). Students are solely responsible for any costs associated with taking the HESI® Admission

     Assessment (A2)

- Applicants must take the HESI® Admission Assessment (A2) as one comprehensive exam on the first attempt. Each student is only allowed to take the exam twice per nursing application period (once per year). Any sections of the exam of which the student would like to improve scoring may be taken again without retaking the entire exam. Highest scores achieved by the students in each area of the HESI® Admission Assessment (A2) will be utilized when ranking the applicant's Composite Score.
- Required Categories:
  - Anatomy & Physiology
  - Biology
  - Chemistry
  - Grammar
  - Reading Comprehension o Vocabulary and General Knowledge
- Nursing program applicants must earn at least 75% in each required category to pass the exam. The cumulative score must be 75% or higher.
- The Ranking Composite Score will be calculated on the English Composite, Biology, Chemistry, & Math scores must be 50% or greater.

Once students have met all above requirements a background check will be completed by the Director of Nursing through the New Mexico Caregivers Criminal History Screening Program. An appointment for electronic finger printing will be completed by the Director of Nursing and the student. Note: Fingerprinting is required to complete the background check.

#### Students are required to:

- Pass the New Mexico Caregivers Criminal History Screening Program background check. Prospective students
  are required to complete and pass a security background check prior to being accepted into the NMSU-A
  Nursing program. Past or current criminal violations may prevent a student from completing the degree and
  gaining a nursing license or employment in the field.
- Completion of 10-panel urine drug screen (students are required to submit results upon completion prior to being considered for a seat in the NMSU-A Nursing program).

Note: Students are required to submit all required materials and completed application package to the NMSU-A

Department of Nursing by the designated deadline for the student selection process.

Initial	Number of Injections or Doses Required	Covid-19 & Boosters	Either one injection or two, dependent on the pharmaceutical manufacturer.  As of Spring 2022 Booster by February 9, 2022 or will need to comply with weekly testing if ineligible for the booster.		
	2	MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella/Rubeola)	Series of two required, there is a 28-day period between doses, or you have the option of having a blood draw completed to determine titer levels.		
	2	Varicella	Series of two required, there is a 28 day period between doses, or you have the option of having a blood draw completed to determine titer levels.		
	1	Tdap	Must have one within the last 9 years. An additional dose must be received if the expiration date occurs within the semester in which you are enrolled. If >10 years must receive a Td (Tetanus & Diphtheria).		
	3	Hepatitis B	You must have all three doses in the series. There is a 28-day period between the first and second dose, and a 5-month period between the second dose and the third dose. You must have started the series and complete the second dose to be eligible to participate in clinical practice.		
	1	Annual Flu Vaccine	Must be administered for the current year.		
	1	10 Panel Drug Screen	Required to be completed after the student is enrolled and the student has started the course/s.  Submit a copy of the Drug Screen results directly to the Allied Health Department Director or Administrative Assistant.		
	1	Tuberculosis Test (Two-Step)	Good for only one (1) year. Cannot expire during the semester in which you are currently enrolled. If results are positive, you must provide a cleared x-ray report and complete a TB yearly Health Questionnaire form, or a quantiferon TB Gold.

Submission of an application for admission to the NMSU-A campus does not guarantee the individual/student placement in a NMSU-A nursing program. Admission to the nursing program is competitive and dependent on the applicant's prerequisite ranking.

Admission to the NMSU-A nursing program is a competitive process and is based on ranked admission scores. The NMSU-A Program Admission Score\* is calculated as follows:

Four (4) or more pre-requisite course taken at NMSU	2%

Admission Essay Score (Instructions and topic included in application instructions)	2%
NMSU-A Allied Health Degree	3%

- HESI®Exams will be open from June 20 July 12, 2024

Only exams taken between the dates listed above will be considered for placement in the Fall 2024 AASN program nursing cohort.
