## **Voc-Rehab Check List**

**Step 1:** Apply for Admission: Note this can be a lengthy process due to the transcripts.

(If you are an out-of-state student discuss being an in-state student for **tuition purposes** only)

Step 2: Request Transcripts: College, military and high school transcripts (Remember Transcripts must come from one institution directly to our institution)
