New Mexico State University at Alamogordo David H. Townsend Library Terms and Conditions for Use of Electronic Resources

Use of many of the Library's electronic resources is governed by license agreements which restrict use to NMSU-A faculty, students, staff and other authorized users, and to onsite users of the Library's computer networks.

Most agreements grant access to authorized users for educational, research and personal use. Copyright law (including the protections of "fair use") and contractual license agreements govern the access, use, and reproduction of these resources. Permitted actions generally include: downloading, temporarily storing, or printing discrete reasonable portions of the materials. Prohibited actions generally include: sharing passwords or authorized access codes, systematic downloading of significant portions of the materials, posting copyrighted materials on a publicly accessible website, or commercial exploitation of the licensed information. Each user is responsible for limiting use to individual, noncommercial purposes, without systematically downloading, distributing, or retaining indefinitely substantial portions of information. The use of software, including scripts, agents, or robots, is generally prohibited and may result in the loss of access to these resources for the entire NMSU-A community. Library patrons who violate these license restrictions may have their library privileges withdrawn, including use of electronic resources.
